This team is now a member of the new Skyline Conference sponsored by the B.C. Lions, which includes six school teams from the lower mainland area and the one from Squamish. So organized, it also represents a third phase in football training for those who have and will come up through the GSL Cardinals and Titans.

## Cards Look Good In Third Victory

Last Sunday shades of the old Cardinals returned to the GSL as the local boys topped the Ticats by two points for an 18 to 20 win. Though the lead was small the boys put up a real team effort, according to coach Lochie Brock, playing fine football reminiscent of the undefeated league winning Cards of previous years. The defense was solid, says Lochie, cemented by such players as Art Fors and Mike Buchanan. Twice they held the Ticats on the five-yard line. Passing is improving and the first completion of the season was made by Joe Hobson to Stevie Manson. Another first for the Cards in 1962 was a convert kicked by Bobby Skerratt. Hobson, a third year Cardinal and one of the originals, is having himself a great season. He scored the Cards' three touchdowns and brought his personal tally up to eight majors. It was a hard and well-fought game all the way. The Ticats jumped to an early lead and ran it up to 12-0 at the half. It was from there, with the odds against them, that the Cards made their comeback. Tommy Shields helped them along with two pass interceptions. Hobson scored on three different plays: the first, a bootleg play; the second, a plunge through the line, and the third, a reverse pass. The other points were made by Art Fors' kicking a single and Skerratt's convert. The Ticat threat was ever present and they made the last score of the game on the last play of the game with a touchdown. The Cards, now in second place, play the third place Bears at Squamish next Sunday, Sept. 30, at 2:30 p.m.
